Sharmie gave the interest report for the Lassen County acct for the 2nd quarter, \$105.53 with an admin fee of \$12.96 leaving a net of \$92.57. She also handed out bank statements for July and August. She did not bring financial reports but will bring them next month. M/S/C Tim/Alan to approve the report.

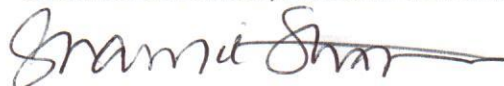
Payroll and bills – M/S/C Tim/Alan to approve the payroll and bills

Sharmie,

Per my message yesterday: Due to the Owl Limited Operating, Dowell was not going to be able to spend all the grant funds before the grant expired on 12/31/19. In order to have a shot at spending all the funds he needed to hire another timco to help with cutting, which will cost him more money. HLP and I have negotiated a an increase in rate subsidy from \$400 per acre to \$425 an acre and an additional \$4 per bdt for chip purchases, beginning at the start on the next MDF Unit, to cover his higher costs. I would like the Board to approve this increase. I have high confidence that Dowell will be able to expend all the grant funds in advance of the grant's closure.
